## Junior Race Team Standards of Conduct

The following standards are in effect throughout the year. Many of the items refer specifically to team travel. Anyone who, in the opinion of the coaches or chaperones, acts in a manner that would interfere with the standards listed below, will be subject to immediate return home (**at the expense of the parent and/or sailor**) and other punishments including barring from future travel regattas or other competition, suspension from practice, or dismissal from the team.

1. SBYF Junior Race Team Sailors shall display proper respect and sportsmanship towards coaches, chaperones, officials, administrators, fellow sailors, and the public. The reputation of SBYF is dependent upon your behavior and appearance.
2. Sailors are prohibited from possession and use of illegal substances and/or use of tobacco and alcohol. Likewise, sailors will not abuse prescription or non-prescription drugs. In addition, any team member found or suspected to be in the **presence of others** (regardless of team affiliation) partaking in any of the above activities will be subject to the same punishments and probable expulsion from SBYF.
3. SBYF Junior Race Team Sailors shall be on time to all team functions including meetings and when the team is scheduled to depart. Likewise, they will be prepared for the event / activity (equipment, clothing, food, water, sunscreen, etc).
4. Sailors will take care of team equipment as well as the equipment of other teams. Sailors will notify the coach or a chaperone if equipment needs repair.
5. The SBYF Junior Race Team travels as a team in chaperone driven cars.
6. Once at the hotel, venue, or designated location, SBYF Junior Race Team sailors may not leave the hotel, venue, or designated location.
7. Curfews established by the coaches and chaperones will be adhered to (Curfew means sailors shall be in their assigned rooms with the lights out, television and radios OFF).
8. At no times will male and female sailors be in the same room together unless a coach or chaperone is in the room or has approved the situation. This applies to SBYF Sailors or members of any other team.
9. Sailors will be held liable for damage done to property at any time during the trip. (This includes the vehicle, hotel, pool, restaurants, etc.)
10. If for any reason during the trip you have a problem, emergency, etc., contact a chaperone or coach immediately.
11. Follow all rules given during the trip by coaches and chaperones.
12. Practices and regattas are considered school events, so all school rules and regulations will be enforced.
