The Santa Barbara Yacht Club Women are pleased with your interest in our scholarship for sailing programs. These are available for girls and boys from age nine to seventeen. Our goal, and the goal of the Santa Barbara Youth Foundation, is to help young people in our community develop, through the sport of sailing, attributes of self-reliance, responsibility, teamwork, and sportsmanship, together with a constant awareness of the requirements of safety.

The Youth Foundation works at building high school racing teams which travel to competitions, an added opportunity, should you become proficient and have the desire to pursue the wonderful world of sailboat racing.

Instruction is provided by instructors who have had experience in teaching and racing. Standards are established for each class, and tests are given to determine skills. **You will be required to pass a swimming test the first, day of your session.** Sabots, Optimists, Lasers, and CFJs are used for instruction. We are awarding full and partial scholarships based on eligibility and financial need. If you are able to pay any part of your tuition, please let us know so that we can help support and involve more young people like yourself.
